2. SPECIFIC DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

3. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the October 21st, 2014 meeting were amended, approved by the council and signed as correct by the chairman.

4. OPEN FORUM

a) Footpaths Committee Meeting.

- i. At a recent Footpaths Committee meeting members were allocated a specific set of footpaths in order to report back to CBC and landowners about damage to stiles etc.
- ii. Strimmers will be handed back to CBC. Slashers will be requested instead.
- iii. In Spring the committee will discuss the idea of a Treasure Hunt in an effort to find younger volunteers.

5. REPORT FROM ALL SAINTS CHURCH, CHALGRAVE

No report this month.

6. POLICE MATTERS

Budget. The PC has received details of the 2015/16 budget for Bedfordshire Police. In correspondence.

7. <u>REPORT FROM CLLR VERSALLION</u>

Cllr Versallion informed the PC, via email, that he has called in the Tilsworth solar farm application. The Chalgrave Manor solar farm will be determined by the planning officers before Christmas.

8. MATTERS ARISING FROM SEPTEMBER 15TH, 2014 MINUTES

a) <u>Police Officer Numbers.</u> The letter sent to PCC Olly Martins regarding police officer numbers has been acknowledged. Ongoing. Cllr Green commented that 800,000 crimes are

not recorded by the police according to a recent newspaper article and BBC report. It was **agreed** to write to the PCC to ask what his views were in light of these reports. <u>Clerk</u>

- b) Jenny Volp: Development Manager Highways Agency (HA) Ms Volp has confirmed that funding will be available to implement the buff coloured road surface and appropriate signage at the A5/C193 junction. Completion will be in the financial year 15/16.
- c) Overgrown Trees; 23 Toddington Road, Tebworth. CBC has given the owners 14 days from October 1st, 2014 to respond to the request for them to cut back the tree. Clerk to follow up with HW Technician. Ongoing. Clerk
- d) Film Club Grant. Ongoing.
- e) <u>20mph through Tebworth.</u> Flitton and Greenfield has had a 20mph limit installed. Cllr Wells will speak to one of his contacts on Flitton and Greenfield PC for information on how they achieved the limit.

- f) <u>Digital Safety Cameras.</u> Cllr Wells reported that applications closed in June 2014. He commented that the costs were also prohibitive for a small parish council.
- g) <u>Tebworth Road, Wingfield.</u> Recent pipework has left the verge looking unsightly. Cllr Parry has contacted CBC to ask if it is working with the contractors to rectify the damage. Cllr Hampson reported that the surface of the A5120 had been damaged where the pipe has under the road. Cllr Wells will contact HW been laid again. Ongoing. MW
- h) **<u>CBC</u>: Consultation on Budget 2015.** Cllr Parry has replied on behalf of the PC.
- i) <u>Blind Summit; Toddington Road/Leighton Road</u>. The PC's request for Blind Summit signs has been passed on to the Transportation Team. Ongoing.
- j) <u>Signage</u>. Some road signs have been repaired on Hockliffe Road. Ongoing.
- k) Vehicle Activated Signs. Some bulbs on the Vehice Activated Sign (VAS) on Toddington Road are not working. Cllr Whitton has contacted Swarco and one of their engineers has checked the sign. Swarco can carry out annual maintenance for £300 approximately. The clerk will find out when the signs were put up. Cllr Whitton will find out how much a new sign costs. Ongoing.

- I) Tree overhanging the VAS on Hockliffe Road. Cllr Whitton has cut this back.
- m) <u>Defibrillator</u>.Cllr Mence has volunteered to be the main contact for the scheme should the PC go ahead. Installation will cost £200 approximately and training £150. Maintenance will be £129 per year. The unit is guaranteed for 7 years. Cllrs present were undecided so they agreed to ask all members for their opinions, for or against. Should the majority vote yes Cllr Green will fill in the Memorandum of Understanding form and return to CBC by December 2nd, 2014.

- n) <u>Council TaxSupport Grant CTSG</u>. Andrew Selous MP has written to the Leader of CBC regarding CBC not passing down the CTSG to parish councils. Ongoing.
- <u>CBC-Dog Control Orders.</u> New orders came into effect on October 19th, 2014. Information will be included in the next Chalgrave News.
- p) <u>Houghton Regis North 2.</u> CBC has not submitted an application for this development yet. DCLG has made a note of Chalgrave PC's objections and suggested to Cllr Green that it makes enquiries from CBC.
- **q)** <u>Chalgrave Manor Solar Farm.</u> Cllr Parry confirmed that affected parishes including Chalgrave receiving s106 money because of this development is possible.

<u>Speed Limits.</u> Cllr Green asked if Toddington Road and Hockliffe Road were considered to be strategic roads. If not he sees no reason to stop pressing for a 20mph limit, particularly

14. <u>HIGHWAYS</u>

a) <u>Parkview Lane.</u> The Area Steward has responded to a request by the PC for a long term resolution to the problem and more frequent gully cleaning. Nothing is planned on the forward four year programme. Gullies are only cleaned once every three years in line with CBC policy. Additional cleaning can be arranged through the area teams. However the Area Steward advised waiting until after leaf fall is complete for this year. It was **agreed** that Cllr Parry sends very strong letter to CBC regarding the infrequency of gully cleaning as the pipes silt up. Ongoing.
