3. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING

The minutes of the December 16th, 2014 meeting were approved by the council and signed as correct by the chairman.

4. REPORT FROM ALL SAINTS CHURCH, CHALGRAVE-Mr S. Calder

- a) Parochial Church Council Meeting. The next meeting will be held on Wednesday January 28th, 2015, 6pm at The Plough, Wingfield. Cllr Parry will attend. PP
- b) <u>Standing Order</u> has been set up so that people can give to the church even if they are unable to attend services. This information to be put on the Chalgrave website and in the Chalgrave News.
- c) <u>Accounts.</u> Mr Calder gave a summary of the accounts. The church has received £17,000 more than expected and there has been less expenditure than expected so it is in profit at the moment. In answer to a question Mr Calder said the running cost of the church was £17,000. Cllr Green asked about the Pest House fund. Mr Calder replied that the land was sold and St Albans diocese holds the fund but All Saints can use the interest.
- d) Attempted Break-in occurred recently.
- e) Events. Mr Calder will forward the pew sheets, which contain details of upcoming events, to the website committee.
- f) Potholes. Cllr Osborn will report the potholes on Church Lane.

- <u>b)</u> <u>Anti-social Behaviour.</u> One incident reported between December 1st, 2014 and January 1st, 2015.
- <u>c) Incident Reporting Board.</u> Cllr Osborn suggested putting a message board outside the Queen's Head. This would be used, for example, if a crime had taken place in the parish to ask people if they had witnessed anything unusual or to report details of speeding vehicles. Cllr Parry will write something for The Chalgrave News. Cllr Osborn will acquire a board and pens. PP; DO
- <u>d)</u> <u>800,000 Unreported Crimes.</u> The PC has received a letter from Inspector Bill Abram, Staff Officer to the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) in response to the PC's letter. He states that, at 88%, Bedfordshire is above the national average of 81% for recorded crimes. Letter in correspondence.
- e) PCC's Request to increase Police Precept. PCC Olly Martins is carrying out a survey asking people if they would accept a 15.8% increase in the police precept which would pay for 100 more police officers. This would amount to 48p a week for Band D households. Cllrs will respond individually. Cllr Parry will add the information to his chairman's report for the Chalgrave News.
