1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

- 2. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN AND VICE-CHAIRMAN.
- a) The current chairman, Cllr Parry, stepped down. Cllr Wells took the chair pro-tem.
- b) <u>Nominations for Chairman</u>. Cllr Hampson nominated Cllr Parry. This was seconded by Cllr Wells. The vote was unanimous. Therefore Cllr Parry is duly elected as Chairman.
- c) <u>Nominations for Vice-Chairman</u>. Cllr Wells nominated Cllr Green. This was seconded by Cllr Parry. The vote was unanimous. Therefore Cllr Green is duly elected as Vice-Chairman.

9. MATTERS ARISING FROM MARCH APRIL 21st, 2015 MINUTES

- a) <u>20mph Speed Limit.</u> Awaiting reply from the Traffic Management Officer Bedfordshire Police. Follow up. <u>Clerk</u>
- b)<u>Defibrillator.</u> Mr Mence explained that a maintenance agreement for the defibrillator was required. Community Heartbeat has stated that details of the AED Maintenance programme should be confirmed by the end of May. In the meantime the PC hopes to arrange training on how to use the defibrillator for mid-June 2015. Mr Mence checks the defibrillator weekly and monthly. **RM: Clerk**
- c) <u>Water Leak.</u> The water leak outside the Grand Chapel, Toddington Road has been fixed. Repair of the damage to the building ongoing.
- d)<u>Computer Recycling.</u> The first collection from the collection point at The Plough, Wingfield is on May 28th, 2015. Cllr Wells has put an article in the Chalgrave News advertising the scheme.
- e) <u>Boundary Gates.</u> The PC has received a quote for £375 to paint the boundary gates and repair the bus shelters. Another quote is due by the weekend. Cllr Hampson has contacted CBC to find out if the gates can be sponsored but has not yet received a reply. Ongoing.
- f) <u>DCLG: Brown Field Land.</u> Response received from the Director of Regeneration CBC. In correspondence.
- **g)**<u>Revised bus timetables.</u> After discussion about the current timetable Cllr Whitton agreed to contact Paul Dodge, Public Transport Manager CBC to find out:
 - i. if CBC have a duty to provide buses
 - ii. if there could be flexibility in the timetabling of the buses e.g. a more frequent service two days a week rather than infrequent buses every day.
