### c) Vacancy Update

The PCCs of All Saints and St Georges met with the Bishop of Bedford and the Archdeacon of St. Albans in Toddington on January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The Bishop confirmed that neither church will close and would remain as a Benefice. However, due to congregation numbers and finances, it is not possible to provide a full time priest cover. The intention is that the ministry will move to a half share interim ministry. This will not be a permanent position and could change back to full time in the future. The Bishop will be identifying suitable candidates and then the PCC representatives will meet them. Mr Calder will continue to keep the PC updated.

d) <u>Roof update.</u> Work on the roofs will commence on 30<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 (after the funeral of Ron Dennis). It will take approximately 10 weeks for completion and will involve scaffolding and a tin covering over the whole church to protect the workforce and roof itself. The church will be classified as a building site so no entry to it is to take place other than for scheduled services or by previous appointment via the Churchwardens. The work could be finished before Easter.

### 7. MATTERS ARISING FROM DECEMBER 20th, 2016 MINUTES

- d) <u>Featherbed Lane.</u> Cllr Green recently contacted Cartography Administration at Garmin to inform them that Featherbed Lane was being incorrectly called New Barn Farm Lane. Cartography Administration has responded saying that it had reported the error to their data provider and it should show up on a future release. Ongoing.
- e) <u>Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS); Toddington Road</u>. Clerk to follow up on a previous request to HW to repair the sign. <u>Clerk</u>
- f) <u>Wingfield Festival of Britain Sign.</u> Signs of the Times removed the sign shortly before the end of last year and have repaired it. It will be re-installed soon.
- g) <u>Parish Council Computer.</u> The clerk is applying for a Transparency Code grant to purchase a new computer plus a scanner/printer. Ongoing. <u>Clerk</u>
