9. DECEMBER 2017/JANUARY 2018 CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED

a) <u>CBC Highways: Proposed Speed Limit Changes in Tebworth.</u> HW is undertaking a statutory consultation on a proposal to raise the speed limit on Toddington Road and Hockliffe Road to bring it in line with the Department for Transport guidance. The proposal will see the speed limit on the approaches to the village where there is residential development on one side of the road only increased to 40mph. The 30mph speed limit will change where properties appear on both sides of the road. HW will also be looking to change the signage to increase awareness of the double bend and provide an advisory speed limit of 20mph through this section.

The consultation commences on Thursday 25th January and closes on Thursday 15th February.

The PC will organise a leaflet drop to residents and ClIrs Whitton and Wells volunteered to talk to as people as possible about the proposal. ClIr Wells will also put the information on the website and on Facebook. It was agreed that the PC would submit comments opposing the proposal. PP; MW; PW
