b) Bedfordshire Police: Serious Youth Violence.

- c) Queen's Head Pub. Following the clerk's application for the garden to be included as part of the pub's Community Asset status, Cllr Parry has emailed Cllr Versallion to ask why the garden has not been included as part of the Community Asset. - e) <u>Tebworth Pond.</u> Tribunals Service has advised the PC that its application for possessory title should now be implemented by Land Registry. It also advised the PC that first registration usually results in the cancellation of Caution against First Registration of the same area by the same party. They suggested checking with Land Registry. Clerk to follow this up.
- f) <u>CBC Local Plan: M1 to A6 Link Road.</u> Cllr Parry has spoken to Hockliffe PC about the frequent congestion through Hockliffe particularly for northbound traffic. Highways England has plans to detrunk the A5 and divert traffic westbound along the A505. The A5 will have a 7.5 tonne weight limit. Both Highways England and Hockliffe are in favour of the scheme. Approval is needed from Bucks County Council as part of the A505 is in that county.
