2. MINUTES OF MAY 19th, 2020 MEETING

The minutes of the May 19th, 2020 meeting were approved and signed as correct by the chairman.

4. POLICE MATTERS

- <u>a)</u> <u>Crime Figures.</u> One crime reported in April: theft from a motor vehicle on Toddington Road, Tebworth. No crimes reported in May
- **b) PC Konopka** has sent apologies for the May meeting.
- **c) Toddington Station.** A 2nd officer is to be allocated to the station.

5. CHURCH REPORT by the Rev Linda Washington

- a) Response to Corona Virus. The church is still closed but we are taking gentle steps forward to open soon for individual private prayer. Please contact either Rev Linda or Rev Nigel Washington. However the minister is not yet allowed to lead formal prayers or services.
- b) <u>Current Plans.</u> We hope to open once, maybe twice, a week for an hour or so. Times will be published on the noticeboard, web site and Facebook page. If people have been self-isolating they may prefer to go into the church at a separate time from other visitors. Please get in touch so we can help.
- c) <u>Funerals.</u> Small funerals with limited numbers of people attending can now be held in church.
- d) Online Services are held regularly. Everybody is welcome.

6. REPORT FROM WARD COUNCILLOR VERSALLION

- a) No report this month from Cllr Versallion.
- **b)** Ward Cllr Grant Scheme Extension. Some months ago Ward Cllrs were allocated £2,000 to help local groups in their wards. Any grant given has to be match funded. The additional £1,000 they've recently been allocated does not require match funding.

7. MATTERS ARISING FROM MAY 19th, 2020 MINUTES

a) Fly Tipping.

- i. <u>CCTV Signs</u>. Two signs have recently been erected in Tilsworth. The PC asked CBC for identical signs at popular fly tipping spots in the parish. CBC has agreed to put 3 signs up, 2 on Chalgrave Road and 1 on Tebworth Road. Ongoing.
- ii. Roving Camera. Cllr Masters said that once the signs are up CBC will come out with a roving camera. The PC would not be informed when this would happen or of the location.
- iii. <u>Dummy Cameras.</u> CBC has responded to Cllr Green's query saying that fake cameras are not illegal but do need to comply with the procedures set out for the use of real CCTV cameras.

- **b)** <u>Swift Boxes</u>. Roger Fenwick has installed the three boxes at the Memorial Hall. The PC has sent thanks to Roger.
- c) <u>Defibrillator</u>. Cllr Green will ask Barbara Jackson if the cabinet light is working now.
- **d)** Rural Pubs. Andrew Selous MP has replied to a letter from the PC which expressed concern about the survival of public houses, particularly rural ones. Mr Selous contacted the Department of Health and Social Care and its response is in correspondence.

e) Tebworth Pond.

- i. Cllr Day is still waiting to hear from the newt specialist.
- ii. <u>Recent Work.</u> Cllr Day, thanked Barbara Jackson and Lesley Smith for painting the railings recently. She also thanked John Parker for coppicing the willow by the road. She has tried out the new rake on the pond weed.
- iii. Moorhens are nesting on the pond at the moment. However work can be carried out soon now that up to 6 people can meet outdoors. Volunteers welcome.
- iv. Cllr Green is concerned about the pond by Lane Farm. It is a breeding pond for frogs and toads but appears to be filling with builders' waste. Cllr Parry will speak to the site manager.
- f) Memorial Hall Grant 2020. The PC agreed a grant of £825 at May's PC meeting, an increase of 50% on the recommended amount for 2020. However the hall has recently been awarded a £10,000 grant from CBC. Roger Masters, Chairman of the Hall Committee, has asked the PC to hold back the extra 50% for now and he will come back to the PC later in the year if the hall needs it.
- g) <u>Chalgrave Sports Club Grant 2020.</u> The PC has received a letter of thanks from the treasurer of the Sports Club for this year's grant. He also informed the PC that the club has applied for a grant from CBC and he will keep the PC informed of the result.
