# 2. MINUTES OF September 15th, 2020 MEETING

The minutes of the September 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 meeting were approved and signed as correct by the chairman.

# 4. POLICE MATTERS

- a) Reported Crime. One crime reported in September 2020: Theft of a motor vehicle, Wingfield Road September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020
- **Fly Tipping.** In order to tackle fly tipping across Bedfordshire the NFU Local Adviser has brought together enforcement officers from all 3 Bedfordshire councils, along with a representative from the Rural Crime Team to form the pan-Beds fly-tipping group. Information in correspondence.

# 6. OPEN FORUM

Cllr Parry is on the Bedfordshire Association of Town and Parish Councils (BATPC) and he represents them at the London Luton Airport Consultative Committee. He has put information about proposed changes relating to Luton Airport in correspondence.

# 7. MATTERS ARISING FROM SEPTEMBER 15th, 2020 MINUTES

- a) <u>Lords Hill Roundabout.</u> Highways England has agreed to review changes without awaiting the RSA4 survey. However there have been delays due to further research. HE is also looking at all three roundabouts on the A5-M1 link road. Ongoing.
- **b)** Fly Tipping: CCTV Signs. No longer considered by the PC now that the pan-Beds fly-tipping group has been formed-see 4b) above
- c) <u>CBC Local Plan.</u> The Inspector's report is in correspondence.
- **d)** Flooding on Corner opposite the Queen's Head, Tebworth. CBC has written to the residents of Holly Tree Cottage and Buttercup Farm as some of the drainage pipes run through their land. Ongoing.
- e) Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government: Planning Policy Reform. The government is holding a consultation on the reform of the planning process. Consultation ends on October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020. Cllr Parry will respond on behalf of the PC.

- **Maintenance of Assets; Quotes.** The PC is waiting for quotes for repairing and refreshing the bus shelters, notice boards and benches. Ongoing.
- g) <u>Festival of Britain Tebworth Sign.</u> One of the upright posts has been damaged which has caused the sign to bend. Signs of the Times (SOTT) has offered to remove the sign and repair any damage caused to it. Progressing.
- h) <u>Boundary Sign.</u> The Wingfield boundary sign has been damaged at the bottom right-hand side corner. SOTT is seeing if they can repair the damage. Ongoing.
- i) <u>Cleaning Road Signs</u>. Cllr Parry will carry this out in the coming months. Ongoing.

### 13. TEBWORTH POND

- a) The gate which gives access to the back of the pond has been installed.
- **b)** Most of the **pond weed** pulled out of the pond has been removed and some has been left in bags by the gate ready to be collected.
- c) Hedge. Cllr Day will arrange for the hedges to be cut.

d) <u>Newt Specialist</u>. Cllr Day had a site meeting with the specialist at the end of September. He is not keen on encouraging Gret Crested Newts to Tebworth Pond because of run-off from the road. However he would support anyone who would be interested in making a wildlife pond in their garden.

#### 14. HIGHWAYS ISSUES

- a) Wild Flowers opposite the Queen's Head. Cllr Green previously suggested planting wild flowers on the wide verge opposite the Queen's Head. Cllrs Parry and Green and the clerk had a site meeting with Steve Halton-Senior Countryside Officer at CBC. Cllr Parry is not keen on the idea because of the continuous maintenance involved. Cllr Green will contact Steve Halton to find out what the PC's commitments would be. Cllr Masters expressed concern about visibility to traffic being restricted. Ongoing.
- b) Trees opposite 72 Wingfield Road. Following a complaint from a parishioner about lack of visibility on the bend Cllrs Parry, Warburton and Ludgate met at the site to see what can be done to improve visibility. Cllr Warburton said that there were three elements to the issue; parked cars, speeding traffic and overhanging trees. It is hoped that the latter can be cut back as far as possible although speeding is more of an issue. The parishioner is willing to help maintain that area. Cllr Warburton will investigate further and liaise with the parishioner.

- i. Manhole Cover; Saint Mary's Close. Repaired.
- ii. Warning Sign at Pond Farm. Completed
- iii. Speed Sign on Hockliffe Road. Follow up again request for a new sign. Ongoing.

- d) <u>Damaged Road Surface</u> between 2 Tebworth Road and Lords Hill is due to be resurfaced on October 29<sup>th</sup> (NB. Rescheduled since PC meeting to November 16<sup>th</sup>). Report gulley outside 2 Tebworth Road again to CBC.

- e) <u>Lords Hill.</u> A damaged chevron close to the junction of Lords Hill and Featherbed Lane has been replaced.
- f) <u>Driveway between Nos 78 & 80 Wingfield Road.</u> Cllr Parry has reported the poor condition of the driveway to HW. The issue has been passed on to CBC Housing as #80 is council owned. Ongoing.
- g) Yellow Lines on Wingfield Road. No date for installation yet. Ongoing.
- h) <u>Thorn Turn Tidy Tip.</u> Cllr Green said he could not get an appointment. Cllr Day replied that there are technical issues there at the moment. Cllr Parry suggested trying Clipstone Tidy Tip in Leighton Buzzard.
