## 6. MATTERS ARISING FROM NOVEMBER 17th, 2020 MINUTES

- a) Lords Hill Roundabout. Two Highways England vans were observing the traffic today. Ongoing.
- b) Flooding on Corner opposite the Queen's Head, Tebworth.
  - i. Heathcote Farm recently cleared the ditch alongside Hockliffe Road. This released a lot of water onto the road.
  - ii. CBC has notified the PC that the resident of Holly Cottage has carried out the work on the drainage pipe that crosses his land and he has contacted the Drainage Engineer at CBC. Both have agreed that more is needed to be done about the flooding on this corner. Ongoing.
- c) <u>Maintenance of Assets; Quotes.</u> All work is completed apart from the bench at the corner of Wingfield Road. This will be done once the weather improves.
- d) <u>Festival of Britain Tebworth Sign.</u> Signs of the Times (SOTT) has removed the damaged sign and is repairing it. One of the upright posts has also been damaged and needs replacing. The PC has received a quote of £725 to remove both posts and replace them with wooden ones. Progressing.
- **e) Boundary Sign.** The Wingfield boundary sign has been damaged at the bottom right-hand side corner. The PC has asked SOTT to repair the damage. Progressing.
- f) Parking on Grass Verge. Contact CBC to find out if it has a policy about parking on grass verges and pavements.

#### 11. BUDGET 2021/22

The PC **agreed** to keep the precept at £7,527, the same as the previous year.

The tax base for Chalgrave has decreased from 214 to 213 so the Band D charge will increase by 0.5% from £35.22 to £35.38 per annum.

## 12. HIGHWAYS ISSUES

- a) <u>Damaged Road Surface.</u> The road surface between Heath Farm, Tebworth Road and Lords Hill was resurfaced on November 16<sup>th</sup> but Cllrs Warburton and Levy said the standard of work was poor. Cllrs Parry and Warburton had a site meeting with CBC's Streetworks Manager. He explained that the road had been re-dressed not resurfaced.
- b) Parkview Lane. A large quantity of water collected at the junction of Parkview Lane and Wingfield Road during the recent heavy rain. Cllr Parry commented that the gulley at the junction of Parkview Lane and Wingfield Road needs jetting out. Clerk to look back through the records about previous issues with drainage at this location.

- c) Drains. A drain near Willow Tree Farm, The Lane is blocked. Report to HW.

d) Trees opposite 72 Wingfield Road. Cllr Warburton will arrange a working party in the spring to cut back the growth. Ongoing.

- e) <u>Driveway between Nos 78 & 80 Wingfield Road</u> is in poor condition It is due to be resurfaced in the spring. Ongoing.

- g) <u>Street Signs.</u> The Chalgrave Road sign and the Tebworth Road sign at the junctions with Lords Hill were knocked over some time ago. The Tebworth Road sign has been rectified. Chalgrave Road sign is still to be done. Ongoing.
- h) Mud on The Lane, Tebworth.
- i) The PC has received a complaint about mud on The Lane. Cllr Parry will speak to the farmers using The Lane.

## \*\* Comments

- 1. The large number of applications that have been submitted to provide and store green energy in this area.
- 2. Each application is considered individually by Central Bedfordshire Council Planning. CBC has no strategic plan in place for providing green energy, which would look at the area as a whole.
- 3. All the applications are on Green Belt land, which is also being used for housing developments.
- 4. The Chalgrave Manor Solar Farm application is predominantly on Grade 3A agricultural land. Grade 3 land is defined as good to moderate quality agricultural land and the proposed solar farm site is being used for crop growing at the moment.
- 5. The Councillors queried how much green energy Central Bedfordshire needs to produce and how much it currently produces.

## b) Rights of Way (ROW)

- i. <u>New Gates.</u> The landowner of Watergate Farm has repaired stiles on his land so they will not be replaced with kissing gates. Ongoing.
- ii. <u>Slow Ways.</u> Cllr Green is looking into Slow Ways. This is a network of walking routes using existing footpaths to connect towns and villages all over Great Britain.
- iii. Heritage Trail. There will soon be an app, called Trail Tale, available for the Chalgrave Heritage Trail.
- iv. Way Marker Post. A way marker post lying in the ditch on Featherbed Lane will be put up again. Ongoing.
- v. <u>Heathcote Farm</u> has sprayed off an area, which has improved access across the bridge on Hockliffe Road and onto the footpath crossing the field.
- vi. Bridge. The clerk reported that part of the bridge on FP 8 is rotten.
