6. CHALGRAVE CHURCH REPORT from the Rev. Linda Washington

a) **Events and Special Services**

- i. The Christmas wreath making afternoon in November went well with over 40 wreaths being made.

7. MATTERS ARISING FROM NOVEMBER 16th, 2021 MINUTES

- a) <u>Lords Hill Roundabout.</u> National Highways expect to re-mark the roundabout in Spring 2022 although there is no firm commitment to a date. Ongoing.
- b) <u>Solar Farms.</u> Cllr Green said that a resident has suggested asking the developers for a paved footway and cycleway from the 30mph limit, Toddington Road, Tebworth to the beginning of the paved footway entering Toddington.
- c) <u>Hockliffe Road Speed Sign.</u> Three 'Speed Watch Area' signs are being installed; one at either end of Tebworth and one on Tebworth Road, Wingfield. The locations have been approved by the CBC Traffic Manager. Progressing.
- d) Festival of Britain Tebworth Sign. Repair has been completed.
- e) Parkview Lane Flooding.
 - i. The PC has received a response from the HW Senior Drainage Engineer. HW are looking into developing a solution to improve the drainage but funding is not available yet. The PC discussed having the gulley cleared opposite Signs of the Times. No decision was made. Ongoing.
 - ii. The clerk has contacted CBC regarding the flooding that still occurs on the corner opposite The Queen's Head pub when it rains, asking for improvements to the drainage in this location. Awaiting response. Follow up.
- **f)** CBC Tree Planting Scheme. Cllr Parry has contacted CBC regarding possible tree planting on the land in front of 37-51 The Lane, Tebworth. Ongoing
- **g)** <u>Trees, Parkview Lane.</u> Two more trees on Parkview Lane may require attention. Branching Out has quoted £650 + VAT. Ongoing.
- h) <u>Litter Pick.</u> Cllr Warburton has proposed another litter pick on 30th January 2022. <u>PW</u>
- i) Stop the Arc Group is campaigning to raise awareness of the government's plans to increase the total population of the five counties Beds, Bucks, Northants, Peterborough + Cambs and Oxon by at least 50% by 2050. The PC has supported the campaign.
- j) <u>Co-ordinated Transport System.</u> The PC sent a letter to Andrew Selous MP asking what government plans there are for local bus and train services for improved and accessible transport. Mr Selous has confirmed that he will contact the Department for Transport and CBC. Ongoing.
- **k)** Parish Councillor Vacancy. CBC has not received any requests for an election to fill the vacancy therefore the PC can go ahead and co-opt. Clerk to prepare advertisement. Ongoing.
- **I)** Bedfordshire Police Bobby Scheme. The PC recently donated £100 to the Bobby Scheme and has received a thank you letter from Bedfordshire Police. In correspondence.
