2. MINUTES OF December 21st, 2021 MEETING

The minutes of the December 21st, 2021 meeting were approved and signed as correct by the chairman.

3. SPECIFIC DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Cllrs Day and Masters are on the editorial team of The Chalgrave News. Cllr Green is a member of the Memorial Hall Committee.

4. <u>POLICE MATTERS</u>

- a) <u>PCC Events: Cluster Sessions for Town and Parish Councils.</u> Cllr Parry attended the Cluster Session on January 12th, 2022 via Microsoft Teams. Hopefully a police officer will attend some of the parish council meetings in the future. Cllr Versallion is attending a Cluster Session on January 26th, 2022.
- **b)** <u>**Reported Crime.**</u> One crime reported in December 2021

- c) <u>Alleged Hare Coursing, The Lane, Tebworth.</u> Information in correspondence.
- d) <u>Road Traffic Accident on Toddington Road.</u> Cllr Parry gave a brief summary of the accident, which took place earlier today.

5. <u>REPORT FROM WARD COUNCILLOR MARK VERSALLION</u>

- a) <u>Police Priority Meeting; January 26th, 2022.</u> Bedfordshire Police are currently consulting on raising their precept by £10 per household. CBC will support the proposal providing some of the money is allocated to certain locations e.g. Leighton Buzzard. He suggested that parish councils stipulate in the consultation that rural areas are covered by a police officer. Cllr Parry said that PCC Akinbusoye was going to have 4 extra police officers, making a team of 14, to deal with rural areas and villages.
- **b)** <u>CBC Budget 2022-2023</u> is out for consultation. CBC is proposing a 2% rise in council tax. 1% will be for adult social care. Despite a £2 million government grant CBC still has to make savings of £9 million.
- c) <u>Leighton Buzzard Leisure Centre.</u> Building the new leisure Centre will begin in 2023. What to do with Tiddenfoot Leisure Centre remains unresolved.

- d) <u>Mobile CCTV Cameras for Fly Tipping.</u> CBC has 6 cameras, which parish councils can request the use of. Contact Cllr Versallion or CBC's Community Safety Operations Manager.
- e) <u>Chalgrave Manor Solar Farm.</u> Cllr Parry asked if Chalgrave Parish would receive any s106 money from the developers of the solar farm. Cllr Versallion replied that the PC should be contacted by the developers regarding community funding. A discussion about solar farm applications continued. Locally there is an application for two solar farms, one in Tebworth and one by the A5 opposite the junction of Hockliffe Road. There is another potential application in the Stanbridge area.

6. CHALGRAVE CHURCH REPORT from the Rev. Linda Washington

a) <u>Christmas Services.</u> All Christmas services were able to be held this year, unlike 2020, although attendances were lower than normal due to Omicron cases.

b) Events and Special Services

- i. 9.30am services resumed at All Saints on January 2nd, 2022
- ii. The Christmas wreath making fund raising afternoon in November went well.
- iii. The Pop-Up Café at Chalgrave Memorial Hall on December 1st, 2021 was well attended. The Café is planned for each third Wednesday of the month, the next being on January 19th, 2022.
- iv. Youth Group and Messy Church will resume in February 2022.
- v. Queen's Platinum Anniversary. The church is planning a service or special event to celebrate the anniversary.
- c) <u>Fundraising Committee</u> will meet in the new year to plan the events for 2022 including some that the Church and the PC can do together. The church now has a card reader so online donations can be made in church, online and using the QR code. The church has a link with the Easyfundraising website. Funds can be raised by choosing All Saints Church-Chalgrave as the chosen charity.
- d) <u>Maintenance.</u> Some plasterwork repairs in the kitchen area and possible dry rot in one of the beams in the chancel are being investigated.
- e) <u>Church Grounds.</u> Thanks given to the gardeners for their regular commitment to keeping the grounds maintained. Thanks also to Roger Fenwick for cutting back a conifer and fixing the gate.

7. MATTERS ARISING FROM DECEMBER 21st, 2021 MINUTES

- a) <u>Lords Hill Roundabout</u>. National Highways expect to re-mark the roundabout in Spring 2022 although there is no firm commitment to a date. Ongoing.
- **b)** <u>Hockliffe Road Speed Sign.</u> Three 'Speed Watch Area' signs are being installed; one at either end of Tebworth and one on Tebworth Road, Wingfield. The locations have been approved by the CBC Traffic Manager. Progressing.

c) Parkview Lane Flooding.

- i. HW are looking into developing a solution to improve the drainage but funding is not available yet. The PC **agreed** to having the gulley cleared opposite Signs of the Times, although this would not be a permanent solution. Ongoing.
- ii. The clerk contacted CBC regarding the flooding that still occurs on the corner opposite The Queen's Head pub when it rains, asking for improvements to the drainage in this location. Awaiting response. Follow up. Contact CBC to try to arrange a site meeting. **PP; Clerk**
- d) <u>Trees, Parkview Lane.</u> Two more trees on Parkview Lane require attention. The PC has accepted the quote of £650 + VAT from Branching Out. Work is scheduled for February 17th, 2022. Ongoing.
