5. REPORT FROM WARD COUNCILLOR MARK VERSALLION

- a) <u>Chalgave Manor and Tebworth Solar Farms.</u> Parish Councils can contact the developers directly for funding for specific projects. Cllr Versallion recommended obtaining a written agreement before planning consent is given in the case of Chalgrave Manor Solar Farm.
- b) McDonald's Hockliffe. Cllr Versallion has written to the branch about the amount of litter generated around the area. He has also contacted the Head Office. Cllr Parry said he met with the manager who informed him that they have random litter picks 100 yards either side of the branch. Cllr Parry and Cllr Warburton will arrange for a combined litter pick.
