7. MATTERS ARISING FROM MARCH 28th, 2023 MINUTES

a) <u>Chalgrave Manor and Tebworth Solar Farms.</u>

i. Nicolas Martin, Director of <u>Aton Energy</u>, the developer of Chalgrave Manor Solar Farm, has confirmed to Cllr Versallion that they will be providing £100,000 for Community Funding to provide economic benefits to the local community. These include the installation of free solar panels on the roofs of schools in Chalton and Toddington, education packs, and information signage at the site. Cllr Parry

commented that there should also be annual payments as the installation is scheduled to last 30 years. Ongoing.

- ii. The Memorial Hall is putting forward a proposal for the new playground to <u>Enso</u>, the developer for Tebworth Solar Farm. Progressing. <u>PP</u>

12. HIGHWAYS ISSUES

- a) Lords Hill. The faded white lines from the Lords Hill roundabout to Tebworth Road, Wingfield have been remarked.
- b) <u>Chalgrave Road Closure.</u> The road will be closed from June 19th-August 18th, 2023 in order to install a high voltage power cable and ducting. The PC has asked HW not to divert traffic down Tebworth/Wingfield Road.
- c) <u>Double Yellow Lines.</u> Cars are being parked on the double yellow lines again.
- d) <u>1 Home Farm.</u> The PC has asked for a site meeting with HW to discuss how the corner can be made safer. No response yet. Ongoing.
- e) <u>Chalgrave Road/B5120 Junction.</u> The hedge on the Toddington side of the junction is overgrown and restricting visibility, particularly when trying to turn right onto the B5120. CBC has said that the hedge is on private land. The PC has contacted the landowner requesting that the hedge be cut back. Ongoing.
