a) Report by

- i. PCSO Apostolidis and PC Arain are part of the Leighton Buzzard based Community Team.
- ii. 5 Officers have been lost in the area therefore there is more pressure on those that remain.
- iii. Positive action is being taken over nuisance motor bikes.
- iv. Cllr Parry asked about hare coursing. PCSO Apostolidis replied that the police take countywide action against hare coursing.

5. PRESENTATION By MALCOLM HILLSON AND FRANCIS CALDWELL

Ref: Ivy Farm Barns Plot 2.

Mr Hillson began by giving some background to the Maulden Vale Development company. The developers are seeking retrospective planning permission to retain the grey concrete cladding that has been used instead of the larch or oak cladding that CBC originally approved. The PC voiced its objection that Plot 2 in its current state does not blend in with its surroundings and contravenes planning rules within a conservation area. Cllr Warburton asked if a darker cladding could be used. The PC will continue to press CBC with its objection.
