## 7. MATTERS ARISING FROM OCTOBER 17<sup>th</sup>, 2023 MINUTES

#### a) Chalgrave Manor and Tebworth Solar Farms.

The Memorial Hall Committee is hoping to secure some funding for the new playground from Enso, the developers of Tebworth Solar Farm. The PC is hoping that Enso will help to fund future community projects as well as any current ones including the playground. The PC has received the Hall's latest accounts. Ongoing.
